We will continue Module 1-Overcoming Reading Challenges Near and Far. Students will continue analyzing challenges children in other countries face in accessing books and then analyze their own challenges, specifically with reading. In addition to continuing close reading strategies for finding the gist, answering questions, determining the meanings of words (including figurative language), and finding the central message, students will write informative paragraphs and critique and revise those paragraphs with partners. At the end of the unit, students will write reading contracts, read an excerpt for an audio book, and create a reading strategies bookmark.

Math



Students will continue multiplying and dividing. They will learn the relationship between multiplication and division, solve for unknowns in multiplication and division, and solve multiplication and division word problems and explain their reasoning.



Social Studies/Science



In Science students will learn about force and motion. Students will also participate in an egg drop challenge during the unit. Students will begin learning about matter.
