We are excited to start our new literacy curriculum, LearnZillion EL Education Language Arts Curriculum. We will begin Module 1: Becoming a Close Reader and Writing to Learn. It's topic is Overcoming Reading Challenges Near and Far. Students will read texts related to the topic and practice close reading strategies to refer to the text to ask and answer questions, recount stories, determine the central message, and understand unknown words. Students will write informative/explanatory texts to examine a topic and convey ideas and information clearly.





Students will learn strategies to multiply and divide, write equations to represent multiplication and division problems, solve multiplication and division word problems, and explain their solutions.



Social Studies/Science



In social studies, students will learn about citizenship and how citizens contribute to their communities.
